 Dusty/herbal nose and complex fruit-driven palate with tightly wound tannin structure. \$17.95

**Beelgara Estate Range Cabernet Merlot 2009**  
 Soft, spicy plum aromas and lovely soft palate with sweet oak dominating. \$8.99

**The Wine Society Clare Valley Riesling 2009**  
 Full-flavoured wine that's all fresh lemons and limes with hints of rose petal aromatics. Slightly sweet and oily in the mouth, with a good finish. \$11.99

**Buller Sinister Man Victoria Chardonnay 2008**  
 Toasty/oaky nose and reasonable weight of toasty peachy flavours with a dash of spice. \$10

**Deakin Estate Chardonnay 2009**  
 Creamy butterscotch nose and slightly oily, complex and savoury palate. Would be great with food. \$10

**Deakin Estate Moscato 2009**  
 Limes on the nose with musky nuances. Sweet fruit palate with attractive lemon zest acidity. \$10

 Fresh nose smells of strawberry and Ribena. Seamless red fruit palate. Some sweetness. \$15

**Ballast Stone Stonemason Currency Creek Rose 2009**  
 Jubey raspberry jelly aromas and very interesting sweet and spicy palate. \$12

**De Bortoli Deen Vat 1 Durif 2008**  
 Big oaky/plum style. Licorice characters on the nose and a chewy tannic palate with good balance between oak and fruit. Drink with red meat! \$12.90

Solid wine with restrained, earthy, cassis bouquet and complex berry/tobacco palate with nicely integrated tannins. \$18.99

**Sam Miranda King Valley Snow Road Cabernet Merlot 2008**

Toasty oak and coffee ground characters dominate the nose, with blackberry flavours on a big, chunky, muscular palate. \$12

**Second Nature McLaren Vale Cabernet Shiraz Merlot 2008**

Dark and inky wine with savoury/herbal aromas and lovely earthy/forest floor flavours. \$18

**Beach Head Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2007**

Savoury, briary style with a touch of leathery age and some pretty powerful tannins. \$15

**Handpicked Peter Douglas Selection Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2006**

Attractive mint and mulberry fragrances and nicely structured palate with 'different' spectrum of flavours. \$18

**Bud Naked McLaren Vale Shiraz Tempranillo NV**  
Well-structured, soft and very approachable wine with good length and depth of sweet, ripe fruit. \$19.99

**McPherson Basilisk Central Victoria Cabernet Merlot 2008**  
Rich, full-bodied style with a complexity of ripe berry fruit and chocolaty oak. Good length. \$17.99

**Swings & Roundabouts Margaret River Cabernet Merlot 2008**  
Smells smoky and toasty and tastes of cassis and butterscotch. Good length and balance of tannins. \$19

**Windowrie The Mill Central Ranges Cabernet Merlot 2008**  
Ripe blackberries mingle with traces of sour cherries Nicely framed by dark chocolaty oak. \$16.99

**Goose Island by Serafino McLaren Vale Cabernet Merlot 2008**  
Extraordinary ripe, liquored, blackberry compote nose and "yummy" jammy/raised flavours. \$13

**Ballast Stone Stonemason Currency Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Sound, faultless wine with simple black cherry fruit and grainy tannins. Has flavour and texture. \$12

Swirls of eucalypt on the nose and tart, briary fruit on the palate, with ripe tannins to support. \$17.99

**Koonowla The Ringmaster Clare Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2007**  
Developed earthy/savoury style with some nice chocolaty/prune elements. \$16

**Red Knot by Shingleback McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Classic cabernet nose: herbal and earthy with intense fruit flavours. "Very satisfying drink." \$14.95

**Richard Hamilton Hut Block McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Spearmint intensity on the nose and velvety-soft in the mouth, with perfumed fruit and bitter chocolate traces. \$17.95

**Argyle Wines Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2009**  
Alluring blueberry, cassis and Asian spice aromas. Palate bright and lively and full of fruit. \$18

**Buller Beverford Victoria Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Sweet oak and green olive bouquet and a big, oaky palate full of rich berry fruit. \$13

**Yalumba The Y Series South Australia Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Softly textured wine with good density of varietal characters - cassis and licorice straps - with sweet tannic spine. \$12.95

**Element of Sandalford Western Australia Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**  
Very herbaceous style - green and menthol-like, with some pleasant berry fruit beneath. \$12.95

**Bud Naked McLaren Vale Shiraz Tempranillo NV**  
Well-structured, soft and very approachable wine with good length and depth of sweet, ripe fruit. \$19.99

Lavender and rhubarb on the nose and a mix of fruit flavours with a trace of sweet/sour notes. \$13

**Taylors Promised Land South Australia Shiraz Cabernet 2008**

Complex and very oaky, with some pleasant stone fruit aromas and well-balanced nectarine/cassis flavours. 3-5 \$13

**Taylors Clare Valley Shiraz 2008**

Inky/oaky, crimson shiraz with rich, spicy, fruit-cake characters showing a certain savouriness. Nice toasty oak and grainy tannins. Has length and balance. \$18

**Red Knot by Shingleback McLaren Vale Shiraz 2008**

Generous, balanced, yet restrained style with good plum fruit and crisp acidity. Very Rhone-like palate. \$14.95

**d'Arenberg The Footbolt McLaren Vale Shiraz 2008**

Perfumed dark fruit bouquet and generous, well-balanced palate with a delicious complexity of flavours. 3-5 \$18

**Warrenmang Bazzani Pyrenees Shiraz Cabernet 2007**  
Huge peppery/fruit cake-like aromas and big, powerful, ripe flavours with massive tannins. \$13

**Rocland Estate Ass Kisser South Australia Shiraz 2007**  
Nicely integrated, aged wine that's holding up well. Simple fruit, high acid. \$10

**The Wine Society Regional Premium Selection McLaren Vale Shiraz 2008**  
Bright, vibrant, fleshy style with generous new leather, prune and licorice-like characters. Nice tannins and good level of acidity. 3-5 \$12.99

**Bullant Langhorne Creek Shiraz 2008**  
Rich, ripe nose and lovely generous licorice and dark plum palate with floral traces resembling violets. Delicious! \$15

**Hardys Oomoo McLaren Vale Shiraz 2007**  
Good spicy plum fruits linger on the quite complex nose. Palate firm, simple and quite meaty/savoury, with some powerful tannins. 3-5 \$18.50

**Quarisa 30 Mile SEA Shiraz 2008**  
Vibrant ripe berry notes lift off the licoricey nose. Generous fruit flavours with chocolaty development Firm tannins and a long finish. \$9.99

Hot, jube style with intense and dense blackberry/cassis aromas and flavours. Some very well-handled oak. \$18

**Clockwork Margaret River Shiraz 2008**

Super intense colour - "It's like black velvet," suggested one judge. Perfect winemaking, with magnificently ripened fruit, great length of silky tannins and deft use of oak. A stunner! \$17.99

**Fox Creek Red Baron McLaren Vale Shiraz 2008**

Oaky style with lovely elements of spices, licorice, prunes and rhubarb. Good acid backbone. \$17.50

**Link Western Australia Shiraz 2008**

Fresh and lively quaffer with pleasant red berry flavours shining through. \$14.95
